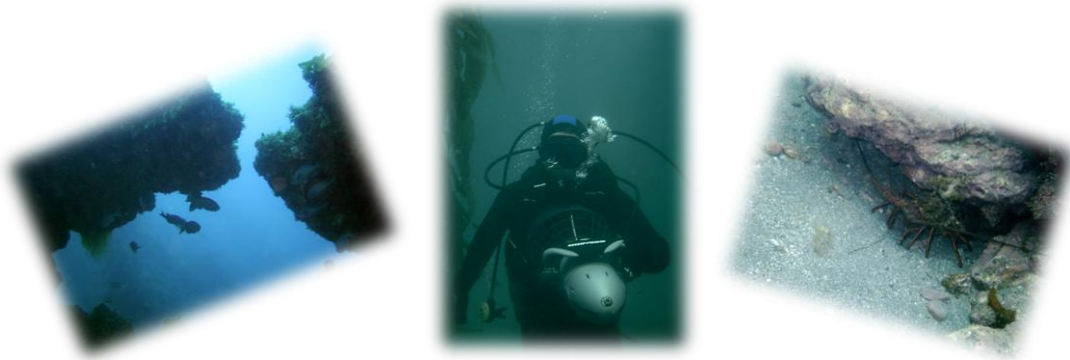


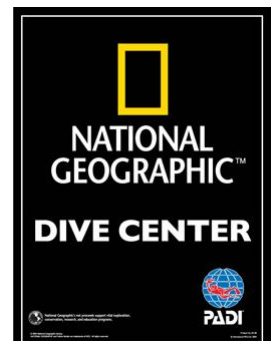


# Specialty Diver Course



The various Specialty Diver Courses offered are an exciting way for certified divers to gain practical knowledge and experience in a specific diving activity. These courses provide the participant with a high-impact program that emphasizes both formal knowledge development and practical diving. Each course allows the participant to gain an in-depth understanding of a specific activity in recreational diving activities, while focusing on the fun of actually diving.

Additionally, five specialty diver certifications are required to attain the highest recreational certification rating in the PADI Diver program: *Master Scuba Diver*



# Specialties Offered

## Altitude Diver

This course covers the skills, knowledge, and techniques of diving at altitudes between 1000 feet and 10,000 feet using the Recreational Dive Planner. 2 dives

## Equipment Specialist

This course covers the operation and maintenance of equipment. It is not an equipment repair course

## National Geographic

This course discusses underwater exploration, navigation, and maneuvering along a delicate reef system. 2 dives

## Deep Diver

This course covers the skills, knowledge, planning, and techniques of diving between the depths of 60 and 130 feet. 4 dives

## Dry Suit Diver

This course covers the skills, knowledge, and techniques of diving with a dry suit. 2 dives

## Night Diver

This course covers the knowledge and techniques of night diving. 3 dives

## U/W Naturalist

This course discusses how to create awareness, evoke a sense of responsibility, and expand the public's knowledge of the aquatic environment. 2 dives

## AWARE Coral Reef

This course covers information about coral reef distribution, diversity, formation and ecology.

## Fish Identification

This course covers the knowledge and techniques for identifying fish common to the local area. 2 dives

## Sea Signs

This course covers the techniques and application of using sign language to communicate in the underwater realm.

## U/W Navigator

This course covers the skills, knowledge, and techniques, of underwater navigation. 3 dives

## Dive Computer

This course covers the skills and knowledge of using a dive computer. 2 dives

## Enriched Air Diver

This course covers the knowledge, skills and techniques for diving with enriched air.

## Search & Recovery

This course covers the techniques and application of a variety of search and recovery methods. 4 dives

## Wreck Diver

This course discusses planning, organization, and techniques in utilizing the use of lights, air supplies, penetration lines, reels limited-visibility diving techniques and emergency procedures 4 dives

## Boat Diver

This course covers the skills, knowledge, and techniques of diving from a boat. 2 dives

## Multilevel Diver

This course covers the knowledge and techniques of multilevel diving. 2 dives

## P. P. B.

The purpose of this course is to assist all divers in polishing their buoyancy control 2 dives

## U/W Photographer

This course covers basic underwater photography with special emphasis on practical photographic techniques. 2 dives

## Diver Propulsion Vehicle

This course covers the knowledge and techniques for diving with an underwater propulsion vehicle. 2 dives

## Project Aware

This course covers information about aquatic ecosystem degradation along with conservation measures to protect aquatic resources.

## U/W Hunter

This course covers the knowledge and techniques for hunting fish common to the local area. Also preparation of the game you took. 2 dives

## \$229 PADI Specialty Diver Course

- One Class and one Pool Session – at Instructors discretion.
- 2 -4 Open Water Dives – the list on the backside informs you of the number of dives required for certification. If no dives are listed then it is a classroom only course.

### Required Materials:

- PADI Specialty Textbook for selected Course: **Price depends on Specialty**
- Compass, Timing Device, Dive Knife, Slate and Whistle, Dive Reel, Primary Dive Light, Back-Up Light, Tank Light, Lift Bag, Safety Sausage, and Wreck Reel – Are just a few items you may need depending on your Specialty Course.

### Recommended Gear:

- For class dives, you must supply a Total Scuba Diving System including: BCD, Regulator, Alternate Air Source, Dive Computer or Submersible Pressure Gauge. At this level you should own your own gear.
- Ocean Gear Rental Package: \$100 (BCD, Regulator, Alternate, Dive Computer, 7mm Dive suit, Hooded Vest)
- As you continue in your Dive Training you will begin to feel more confident and comfortable with your own gear. Talk to one of our helpful Sales Associates to help assist you in this purchase.

### Dive Package:

- Catalina Dive Park 1-day: \$199 (Parking, Transport, Food, Water, & Air Fills NOT included---Gratuity-Additional) See \*Note

### Master Scuba Diver Rating:

- Once you finish your AOW Course, your Rescue Diver Course and any 5 Specialties, our Professional Dive Staff will gladly sit with you to fill out the necessary paperwork for this Rating.
- This is the highest rating for PADI recreational divers.

*\*Note: One Dive Package is required for Full Certification unless being referred elsewhere. See Course schedule to determine Dive Package. You may also be going to other locations where the cost of travel and boat trips may be more expensive. Please discuss this with your instructor as you continue in your Dive Education.*
